Joanne Lau graduated in 2021 with a first-class honours degree in Business Administration and Management (BABAM) with the best dissertation award.

"During the three years at SCOPE, I have learned a lot, and I am very grateful to every professor for teaching me. They have given me a lot of support and encouragement. They are willing to spend extra time to guide us and provide us with help. The whole campus always has a positive learning atmosphere." Joanne said.

"The time management skills acquired at university are valuable to me, I have learnt to manage time effectively in the past few years, especially when I had to cope with school work, part-time jobs, and extracurricular activities at the same time. When you are given many different responsibilities, the ability to prioritise things and manage your time well is the key to success".

Furthermore, I have learnt to embrace criticism. If you fail to achieve an expected result in an assignment, you may feel frustrated. But I have learnt how to face criticism and enhance my capability. No matter which industry we are in, we need to be able to embrace feedback rather than let criticism undermine our confidence and motivation," said Joanne.

"Although we often say "opportunities are reserved for those who are prepared", only those who learn to seize opportunities and are willing to make attempts will gain extra rewards. We must thank our Programme Leader for the school's provision of internship at different international companies and her unfailing support, letting us make continual progress." added Joanne.

Joanne believes that some students may have doubts about their career prospects, but the merit of the business management programme is that it can bring about many possibilities. After reading the BABAM programme, she has a critical understanding of a broad range of topics in the field of business and management. Therefore, she can identify her career aspiration and opt for companies which are attractive to her. She states that "business graduates can confidently play different roles and work at changing environments as well as capitalise on the skills and knowledge learnt almost everywhere."

Ronald Leung graduated with first-class honours in Business Administration and Management (BABAM) in 2021. He believes that "well begun is half done" and "a craftsman who wants to do his work well must first sharpen his tools" (好開始為成功的一半.工欲 善其事,必先利其器.).

"In 2019, I decided to read BABAM run by De Montfort University via CityU SCOPE, a harmonious learning place which has facilitated my knowledge enhancement, offered me opportunities to network, and developed my lifelong learning abilities. BABAM isn't a programme just for learning theories and acquiring a good GPA, but it also helps us understand how to make critical decisions using conceptual frameworks. LAW King Yin

BA (Hons) Public Administration and Management Graduation year: 2021 (Part-time Top-up)

I have been working in the surveying industry for about 6 years. I enrolled on the Public Administration and Management programme in 2019 to improve my competitiveness and broaden my horizons.

Before that, I knew nothing about public administration. After completing this programme, I gained a better understanding of the government's policy making process and structure, particularly the module on "Public policy making." It's about the policy cycle for decision making; the more familiar you are with the stage, the more efficiently you can publish a policy. It coincided with the social movement in Hong Kong that year, so I could easily apply what I learned, such as commenting on government activity through various management theories, policy processes, and analysing the government's policies in the public administration perspective.

Moreover, taking the Housing Specialisation elective modules also enabled my career to be more professional and diversified. In particular, the licensing system for the property management industry was implemented on August 1, 2020. For this reason, before I switch to this professional industry, I need to equip myself. Through this course, I have a deeper understanding of Hong Kong's housing policy formulation, housing market and property management. The programme broadened my horizons, but also helped me lay a solid foundation in the field of property management.

Despite the fact that this programme was intense, and that studying while working was also stressful. I believe it's critical for us to upskill multitasking and time management capabilities, particularly for those aspiring to develop their careers in this industry. This is an excellent chance to put your skills to the test.

Lastly, I would like to express gratitude to our lecturers and tutors. They all have a wealth of experience, not only imparting knowledge from the bottom of their hearts, but also selflessly sharing their valuable working experience with us. They always encourage us to ask questions in class and are open to hearing our thoughts on the problems we face at work. This programme was extremely beneficial to me.

BA (Hons) Public Administration and Management Graduation year: 2021 (Part-time Top-up)

I graduated from the Public Administration and Management (BAPAM) programme in 2021. Before studying the BAPAM, I took a few years out. In 2016, I completed an associate degree at the College of International Education with a major in Bilingual Language and Literature Studies. The COVID-19 pandemic and the social movement in 2019 and 2020 was a hard time for us. The difficulty of making a living drove the necessity to obtain a bachelor's degree. BAPAM, a short term top-up full-time programme is perfect, the low cost drew my attention. The long history and the excellent teaching were some of the reasons why I applied to this programme.

Unlike other students, I've never studied a social science program before. I Lacked the foundational knowledge of Public Administration and Management, which made studying the BAPAM programme tough at the beginning. Thanks to the patience of the tutors, tough times did not last long. The tutors were very kind and provided a lot of information exceeding my expectations of the programme. The Tutors enriched our basic knowledge of public issues and public policies, by giving us detailed information. Also, most of the modules offer chances for us to present a topic, which improves our skill of individual thinking, collecting data and public speaking. Discussions are required after presentations, which improves our skill of critical thinking.

On the programme, experimental workshops were taught creatively, every group was assigned as a stakeholder in a public issue, to act in a city forum and write a simulation report. Our group was assigned as 'media' in The New Territories Land (exemption) Bill. We had to hold a forum and prepare thoughtprovoking questions.

School life in the past year was challenging but meaningful. I am happy to have support from tutors and friends who share the same goal.
